





We Must Be Large in Southeast Louisiana

MCHGNO Requires a Permanent Home

- We need to be in the middle of Louisiana's population center.
- Louisiana has too few treatment options for children.
- The closer a child in out-of-home care is to his or her family, the better the treatment outcomes.
- Being transient in leased space limits our effectiveness.
- Our expanding services need the support of a regional center in southeast Louisiana.
- The integrated pursuit of our mission in Louisiana requires a permanent presence in the Greater New Orleans region.

What Are the Next Steps?

- We have acquired land and it must be prepared.
- 2. Our architect has developed a preliminary master plan.
- 3. We are communicating with local officials.
- 4. We will begin clearing land in the Spring.
- 5. Phase One will house 18-24 children within 3 years.
- 6. We are actively raising funds through donations, targeted gifts and grants, and naming opportunities.

Our Property


- 125 acres
