Tuition Waiver Policy

- It is the OWL Equine Center's Intention that all riders accepted into the program, regardless of ability to pay, have access to our services. Scholarships are awarded as available based on financial need.
- All persons requesting a scholarship must complete an application and submit proof of income.
 ALL INFORMATION SUBMITTED WILL BE HELD IN STRICT CONFIDENCE.
- Scholarship funds are provided on a first come, first serve basis until are funds are allocated.
- The OWL Center determines financial eligibility using the current U.S. Poverty Guidelines, prorated up to 200% of the poverty level. The OWL Center does not provide 100% scholarships for tuition; every rider must pay at least a minimal amount towards their tuition.
- Scholarships are awarded in 10 week increments. If funds are limited, existing scholarship recipients may have to rotate out after 10 weeks to give other applicants an opportunity.
- Scholarships may be forfeited if a participant misses more than 3 lessons per session, or are habitually late to lessons.
